Medford SafePlace Directions

The Medford SafePlace group meets on the first and third Thursday of every month from 7:30 - 9pm at
 the **Grace Episcopal Church (2nd Floor) at 160 High Street in Medford.**

FROM THE NORTH- ROUTE 93:

Take Route 93 South to the Medford Square/Malden/Route 60 Exit. The exit enters a rotary. Take the first road off the exit, which is Route 60 West. Do not stay on the rotary and go back under Route 93. **Stay in the right lane but keep going straight. Go through two sets of traffic lights. This is now High Street. Continue on High Street and pass the Medford Public Library on the right and St. Joseph’s Catholic Church on the left. You will go through a 3rd set of lights near St. Joseph’s and the Library. Grace Episcopal Church is on the left and set back from the street but is only about 2/10^{ths} of a mile after St. Joseph’s and the Library. Parking is behind the Church.

FROM THE SOUTH- EXPRESSWAY TO ROUTE 93:

Take Route 93 North to the Medford Square/ Malden/ Route 60 Exit. The exit enters a rotary. Go ¾ of the way around the rotary (underneath Route 93) and take Route 60 West. **From here, follow the above directions.

FROM ROUTE 95 (Route 128):

From Route 95 take the Route 2 East Exit. This exit is in Lexington. Off of Route 2 take Exit 59/Route60- Arlington Center/Belmont Center. Take a left at the end of the exit and heads toward Arlington Center. This is Route 60 East and goes back over Route 2. You should stay on this road (Route 60) for approximately 4 to 5 miles total. The first major intersection is at Arlington Center. Stay in the center lane and go straight across Mass Ave. Then get into the right hand lane as Route 60 bears right. Remember to stay on Route 60. This will eventually bring you into West Medford. You will pass St. Raphael’s Catholic Church on the right and then pass over a railroad crossing. This is High Street. Go about a mile and you will come to a rotary. You will take the 2nd right off the rotary (almost directly across) and the sign will say Medford Square or Route 60. This is also High Street and Grace Church is on the right just beyond the rotary. Parking is behind the Church.
